

Purpose

The FUSD After School Program provides structured tutorial and enrichment programming for school-age children at many Fresno Unified School District sites. Programs are staffed by qualified after school staff members. DAYS OF OPERATION: The FUSD After School Program operates SCHOOL DAYS ONLY. The program operates on a daily basis to coincide with the regular school calendar, and operates from the end of the school day until 6:00 p.m. **Students participating in the FUSD After School Program are required to participate in all the components of the program.**

Lottery Entry Policies and Procedures

1. State guidelines require that each year the After School Programs re-enroll students into the program.
2. Enrollment is based on a staff-to-student ratio of 1:20.
3. **State guidelines require that all students participating in the After School Program are expected to participate in the program from the end of the school day until 6:00 p.m. Students who leave prior to 6:00 p.m. must have an early release form completed by the parent. The state provides several validated reasons for a child to be released early. This form is an exception not the rule. If a student cannot consistently participate for the entire length of the program, the student will be removed and replaced with a student on the waiting list.**
4. All students in the FUSD After School Program will participate in all state-mandated components of the After School Program. These components are:

Healthy Snack, Homework, Academic Intervention (English Language Arts and Math), Physical Fitness Program, and Enrichment Activities

Please note: Students are provided a homework period with staff support for help. The After School Program does not guarantee that all homework will be completed during this period, nor do we guarantee that staff will be able to check every child's homework for accuracy.

5. Upon acceptance into the program for the 2018-2019 school year, you will be required to attend a mandatory parent orientation.
