We are excited to welcome your child into our classrooms. Our Preschool programs are inclusive, welcoming all children regardless of their toileting status. We understand that children progress at different rates towards full toileting independence. Some may need direct support, while others may require help with occasional accidents.

What is our Toilet Learning Policy?



- A child's self-help skills, such as toileting independence, will not affect their enrollment. Enrollment is based solely on eligibility criteria.
- Children must come to school wearing underwear. Diapers and pullups are **not** permitted.
- For children who are not yet toilet trained, we will collaborate with parents/guardians to create a toilet learning plan during the family connection meeting. Please bring your child in underwear and provide a change of clothes, including shoes and socks, in case of accidents.



Toilet Learning Plan Meeting

If your child needs assistance with toileting, you will meet with the classroom teacher to discuss:

- Your child's current toileting skills
- Home toileting routines and their adaptation to school
- Your preferences for handling accidents
- Classroom procedures for supporting your child
- Resources for toilet learning at home
- Parent and educator commitments
- Communication about your child's progress
- Follow-up meetings
