**District Announces Summer Meals Schedule**

The district will begin its free summer meals program on Monday, June 14, with the current meal program ending Friday, June 11. The hours for summer meal pickup will change, as will some locations, from the district's current free meals program.

Summer meals will be served 10-11 a.m. Breakfast and lunch will be provided at the same time to children ages 1-18, Monday through Friday. Meals for the weekend will be provided on Friday. Also, summer school sites will serve breakfast and lunch to children ages 1-18 during their designated mealtimes, one breakfast and lunch per child.
